

## **Pool Rules & Regulations**

*Watson Farms - Summer 2010*

*The Watson Farms Homeowner's Association goal is to improve the quality of life in the community by upholding the integrity and appearance of the neighborhood, reducing crime and promoting community spirit!*

1. All residents' ages 6 and older are **required** to wear pool wristband upon entry to the pool area. If a resident is *not* current with their dues, they may **not** enter as a guest with another resident.
2. An adult must be present **unless** you are at least 13 years old wearing a green wristband and are able to swim on your own.
3. All residents and guests use the pool and pool area at their own risk and shall be solely responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use.
4. One resident, age 16 and above, may bring **no more** than 4 children to the pool area. The responsible resident must be *in the water* with the children **at all times**.
5. Children 6 and older are not allowed in the baby pool unless accompanied by a guardian that is 16 years of age with a younger sibling. Babies must wear swim diapers at all times. Lifeguards **are not** responsible for children in the baby pool. An adult must accompany children in the baby pool area at all times. As a safety precaution, the baby pool gate must be kept closed so toddlers cannot wander off to the big pool.
6. The pool will be cleared for 10 minutes of every hour for an adult only swim, (over 18 years). During this time, parents or guardians with non-swimmers may take children to pool areas not marked for lane swimming to play and practice as long as the parent remains in the water with the child.
7. Lifeguards are responsible for lifeguarding, maintenance, checking pool bracelets and rule enforcement. For the safety of pool patrons, lifeguards are not baby-sitters.
8. A lifeguard or other authorized person may close the pool due to inclement weather i.e. below 70 degrees, for safety or health reasons, and for any other situation deemed necessary to ensure the safety and best interest of residents and pool users.
9. A lifeguard may deprive any resident or guest of the rights and privileges of the pool area for improper use or conduct.
10. Please dispose of all garbage, wrappers, or gum before getting into or leaving the pool area or getting into the pool. Garbage cans are located throughout the facility.
11. No smoking, glass containers or alcoholic beverages are permitted anywhere in the facility.
12. Swimmers are urged to use the shower before entering either of the pools.
13. No hard play equipment such as hard balls or frisbees are allowed in pool.
14. No running, rough play, spitting, chicken fights, dunking, diving, use of foul language or any other activity that in the opinion of the lifeguard might be dangerous to an individual or to others will be tolerated in or around the pool area.
15. No loud music or loitering will be permitted in the pool area, grounds or parking lot.
16. Residents are liable for loss or damages caused by them or their guests.
17. Additional rules may be posted in the pool area and must be followed.
