## MINI-BARN RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All mini-barns erected on lake properties shall be placed no closer than 5ft to the residence in the rear yard and will be constructed in such a manner to not block neighbor's view of lake.
- 2. All mini-barns will be set at a permanent location on the property.
- 3. All mini-barns will be of gambrel roof style and will be painted or sided to match the color of the residence.
- 4. Trim paint of mini-barn must match residence trim pain in color. Siding or paint color must match residence paint or siding color and be of same material as residence.
- 5. Mini-barn will be no larger than 120sq feet and no smaller than 80 sq ft.
- 6. Mini-barn will not be used to house, keep or shelter any animal, bird, or person of any description. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 7. Mini-barn will not be built on skids or any movable foundation.
- 8. Mini-barns will be constructed of wood only with asphalt shingles to match residence.
- 9. No metal or plastic mini-barns will be allowed.
- 10. Mini-barns on other than lake properties must be placed in the rear yard area only and adhering to coded limitations as set forth by the city of residence.
- 11. No barn will be erected on any easement or common area. It will be the responsibility of the homeowner to remove said barn if constructed in such a manner.
- 12. No mini barn will be erected anywhere except in the rear yard of any property. No side yard construction will be allowed.
- 13. Only those residents with approved applications and location plans on file with the Watson Farms ACC will be allowed to construct a minibarn on their property. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 14. Mini-barn must have at least (1) source of ventilation. Ie: window or roof vent as fire protection.
- 15. No flat or gable roofs will be permitted as they are classed as sheds.
- 16. Double or single doors allowed.
