### > SPRING CLEANUP REMINDERS

- First and foremost: if you receive a violation for an exterior cleanup and you need assistance completing the task, please contact the board via the email listed below. Our goal is to make our neighborhood more neighborly. We would like to see people come together to help each other out and keep our neighborhood looking its' best!
- **Trash bins** are not supposed to be visible from the road per the City of Lawrence Ordinance and our HOA governing documents. Please see our website for a list of alternative ways to store/hide them.
- Algae and mold grow on siding throughout the year, please take the spring to get your siding cleaned up!
- Exterior home upkeep: paint those porches, mailbox posts, and trim!
- Mailboxes: Watson Farms has a standard mailbox with specific color and shape instructions that can be found on the website. Please ensure you are in compliance with our governing documents.
- Landscaping: Please be sure to maintain your grass and weeds throughout the spring/summer.
- Outdoor items: Please be sure to properly store outdoor items out of sight or in your backyard. (lawn mowers, landscaping materials, bicycles, wheelbarrows, etc.)
- Pets: While our neighborhood has great sidewalk areas for pet walking, please be sure your pet is on a leash AT
   ALL TIMES. The City of Lawrence can issue fines for animals not leashed. Also, please be courteous to your
   neighbors. If your pet is known for being vocal outdoors and it irritates you; your neighbors are likely bothered as
   well.
- Architectural Requests/Caliber Portal: The caliber portal has an electronic form for submitting architectural changes for your home/property. Remember most exterior changes, including painting a front door need to be submitted. Please be sure to submit your request before you complete any changes!
